Dear Parents,

We are at the beginning of the final year of your child's International Baccalaureate (IB) cycle and we would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the trust you have placed in us.

As you probably already know, the Extended Essay, the Theory of Knowledge, the CAS programme and the Internal Assessment Papers are specific to the IB diploma. In order to provide our students with the best possible support, we have, throughout this past year, informed them about the objectives of these assignments.

The Extended Essay is a large personal research paper (4,000 words) related to one of the IB subjects. It is carried out under the supervision of a teacher. The nature and amount of the internal assessment works are specific to each subject.

As a result, you may understand that the year 2020/2021 will be partly devoted to the finalisation of these Internal Assessment works. We would therefore like to avoid overloading our students with too much work due to the often poor management of the deadlines imposed by the IBO.

In order to make it easier for our students, we have established an internal calendar with all the deadlines that you will find attached. This schedule should allow you, dear parents, to keep track of your children's work. We thank you for your precious collaboration.

We also inform you that the official registration for the May 2021 exams, which will be invoice at the beginning of the school year, has been set for Friday, October 23rd, 2020.

The Class Teacher, the IBDP Coordinator and all the IB teachers are at your disposal for further information and wish you a pleasant summer.

International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme Y2

For the experimental sciences, the internal assessment takes the form of written reports on work carried out in the laboratory. Students are given one week to write their report after completing the necessary laboratory work.

The respect of deadlines and the submission of reports are imperative conditions for a student's registration for the exams, since the Internal Assessment Papers are an integral part of the final grade obtained in the official session of the International Baccalaureate examinations. **The deadlines given below are indicative and may be modified by teachers during the year.**

Important Reminder	The validation of the 2nd session of the Extended Essay, as well as the submission of the work mentioned above and of the diaries/forms of CAS activities are imperative conditions for the student's registration for the May 2021 exams.

Before the February holidays	<u>TOK</u> : Oral presentation <u>Exp. Sciences</u> : submission of the personal investigation version 1 <u>Visual Arts</u> : Submission of the final "Portfolio", "Comparative Study" and "Curatorial Rationale"

As of end of February 2021	<u>CAS</u> : submission of CAS diaries/forms and final meeting with the CAS Coordinator. <u>Exp. Sciences</u> : submission of the final version of the personal investigation
March 2021	<u>Visual Arts</u> : oral exam (to be decided by the examiner). ENSR High School exams and mock exam.
From Tuesday 6 th to Friday 16 th April 2021	Easter holidays and revision courses (<u>Experimental sciences and Mathematics</u>). The detailed schedule and terms will be communicated later on.
From Monday 26 th to Friday 30 th April 2021	During this week before the official exams, the teachers are available to the students according to their needs.
From Monday 3 rd to Friday 21 st May 2021	Official IBDP examination session.

(The detailed schedule for each examination subject will be communicated at a later date.)

July 6 th 2021	Publication of the results on the Internet. Each candidate will receive a password in February to obtain his/her results personally on the website.
September 2021	Graduation ceremony. The date will be communicated in due course.

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
